Job Description

Position: National Campaigns Coordinator

Organization:

The Regeneration Project is the national office of the Interfaith Power and Light (IPL) campaign. There are currently 32 IPL state affiliates. IPL is mobilizing the religious community to become leaders in the fight against global warming. Over 10,000 congregations of all faiths are involved, in all 50 states. IPLs engage congregations through energy conservation and renewable energy programs, education and outreach, and public policy advocacy.

Position Summary:

The National Campaigns Coordinator will lead national IPL advocacy and education campaigns and support state IPL affiliates' participation in these efforts. A major initial focus will be a coordinated multi-state effort to fight coal-fired power plants and mountain-top removal coal mining. The coordinator will have a wide array of responsibilities, including promoting our national policy priorities and assisting state affiliates with all aspects of advocacy and organizing. Candidates should have demonstrated success in organizing effective campaigns, generating earned media, online mobilization, and issue advocacy. The position is ideal for an experienced campaign organizer who is self-directed and enjoys multi-faceted work. The coordinator should also have experience in climate and/or energy policy advocacy along with at least three years campaign management experience.

This is an opportunity to join a unique and dynamic organization in a newly created, strategic position. State affiliates are in different stages of development, from brand new, all volunteer start-ups to established organizations with executive directors and paid staff. State affiliates' needs vary greatly, and the coordinator will work with each of them to help them have maximum possible impact on their policy priorities.

- Work with IPL National Campaigns Committee to advance strategic policy initiatives
- Work with state leaders and provide them with hands on support and assistance to maximize their impact
- Develop and implement campaign strategies
- Develop fact sheets, action alerts, advocacy materials and website content that all states can use
- Facilitate networking between state IPLs when appropriate
- Provide creative input and work with multiple teams on campaign priorities
- With executive director and state affiliates coordinator to ensure program is meeting strategic priorities
- Work in coalitions with other environmental and faith-based organizations
